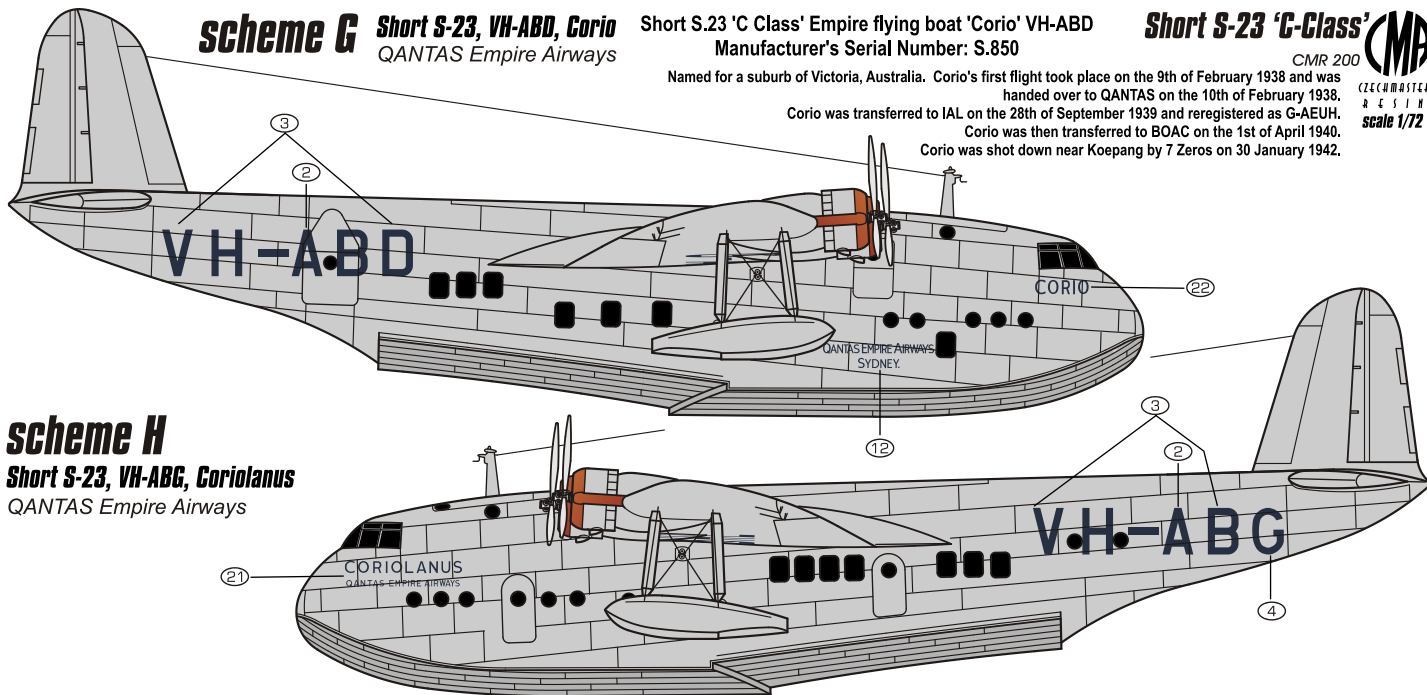

Named for a suburb of Victoria, Australia. Corio's first flight took place on the 9th of February 1938 and was handed over to QANTAS on the 10th of February 1938. Corio was transferred to IAL on the 28th of September 1939 and reregistered as G-AEUH. Corio was then transferred to BOAC on the 1st of April 1940. Corio was shot down near Koepong by 7 Zeros on 30 January 1942.



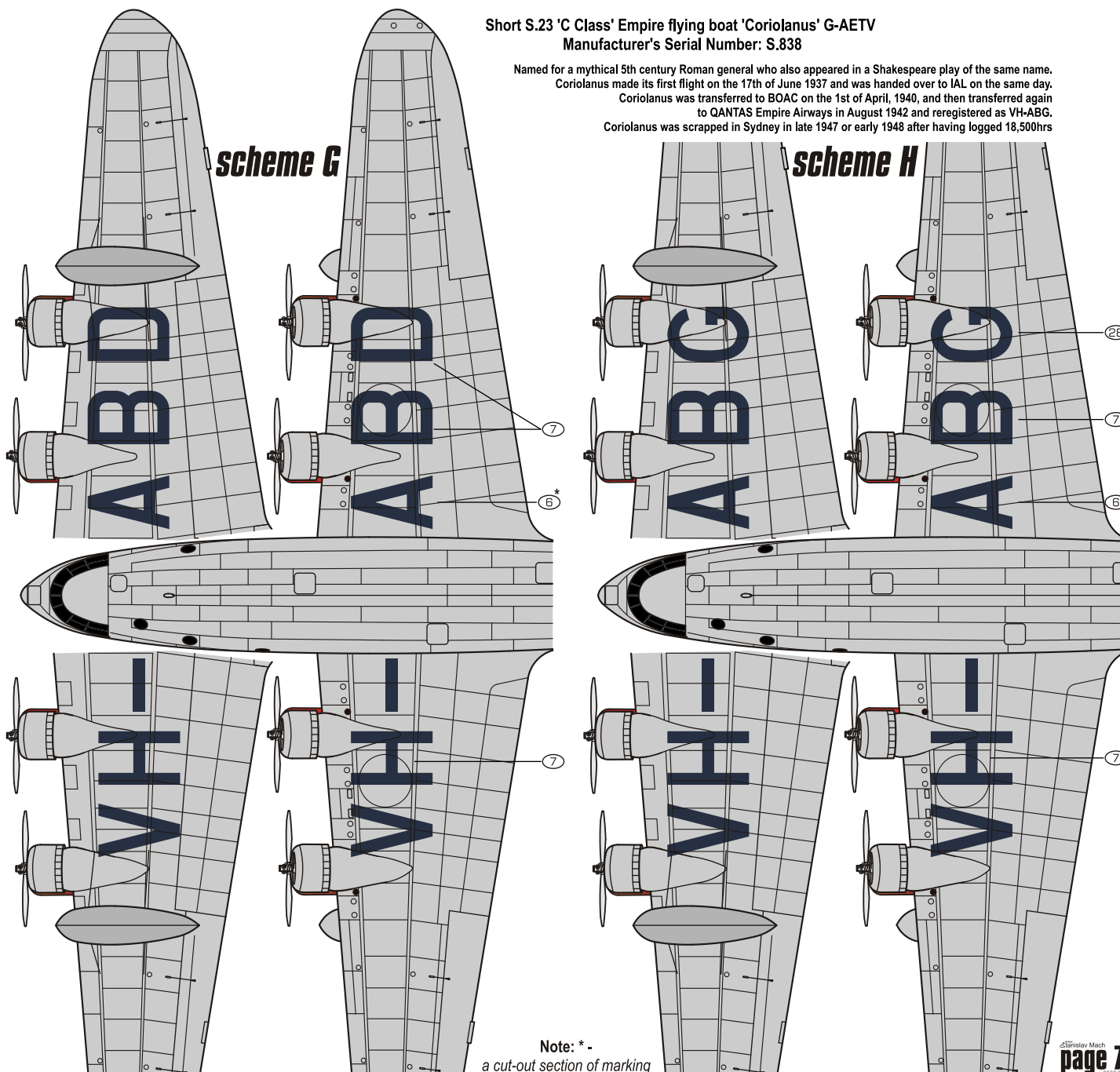

Short S-23, VH-ABG, Coriolanus

Short S.23 'C Class' Empire flying boat 'Coriolanus' G-AETV
Manufacturer's Serial Number: S.838

Named for a mythical 5th century Roman general who also appeared in a Shakespeare play of the same name. Coriolanus made its first flight on the 17th of June 1937 and was handed over to IAL on the same day. Coriolanus was transferred to BOAC on the 1st of April, 1940, and then transferred again to QANTAS Empire Airways in August 1942 and reregistered as VH-ABG. Coriolanus was scrapped in Sydney in late 1947 or early 1948 after having logged 18,500hrs
